An elderly woman is found walking around town during a hot day and appears confused as she circles the block. A citizen sees her, concerned that she is lost, asks her if she is ok. The elderly woman responds saying that she is unsure where she should be going and unable to provide the citizen with a name or number to call. After the citizen asks if she could give her a ride to the Mission, the woman agrees and brings her in.

Arriving at the Mission very hungry and thirsty, she is given food, water and a place to sit and rest. After staff finds out who she is, where she came from, and what the circumstances are, some questions arise and now there is reason for concern. A call is made to Senior Services, Law Enforcement and Adult & Protective Services. After a case worker is assigned, they discover there is a need for the elderly lady to attend court hearings. Because she is comfortable with Mission Staff, they accompany her to the court hearings and continue to provide for her needs. As soon as the court hearings conclude, the elderly woman returns to her home.

I'm sure by now, you're wondering what's up with this story. The elderly woman, suffering from the onset of dementia, had come to this area to visit someone. During the stay, that someone denied her a way home and began utilizing her funds. The elderly woman's sister, who was her caregiver, had been searching for her and had no idea where she was. After staying for a month at the Mission while these agencies worked on her behalf, the woman received help to return to her home in another state.

The Mission cares about EVERY individual that comes our way. We could have easily just done the bare minimum and not addressed her situation but something just wasn't right. I thank the Lord for giving us the ability to help those that can't help themselves as well as the compassion and perseverance to go the extra mile. This is the heart of the Mission.

We are raising campaign funds for the expansion of the Mission from 17 to 70 beds. Phase 1 of the Campaign is complete (adding an overnight stay shelter housing 35 individuals). Phase 2 has begun and will add a Men's 30 day stay facility which will house up to 13 individuals. The final phase will pay off the existing debt on our current facility and will be utilized for women and children. A Children's room with nursery has been a large priority as well as a larger commercial kitchen.
