In the last newsletter, I shared that the Mission would begin building the Men’s Facility as soon as there were sufficient funds in the bank. Well, because of you, we are now at that place in the building expansion where construction will begin over the winter with a target of occupying by the end of summer! After I read that verse in Isaiah 54:2, I saw just how powerful and true God’s Word is, and how many donors have answered the call. You are a true blessing and a part of enlarging the tents at the Mission.

In a couple of weeks, we will be changing over to be the inclement weather Shelter for the 2nd year in a row. As such, we relax the clean/sober rule during inclement so that everyone can come in out of the cold each night. There has been some confusion as to whether or not the Shelter is open all year. It is indeed open for those who have an immediate need during the warmer weather but all guests are required to be clean and sober. We can accommodate 35 guests at the Shelter and are looking for volunteers to help staff from 5 pm-10 pm each night. You can get a volunteer application online, if you haven’t filled one out yet, and either drop it by or email it to the address on the form. It would be a big help to have extra hands carrying food from one facility to another, helping to check people in, or just sharing resource information with guests.

The other wonderful news is that MacHub has relocated to a building between Staples and Izzy’s at 1294 N Hwy 99W. If you have collectables or anything that would sell for more than \$15, please drop donations by during the week from 9am – 4 pm and take a look at our new location. Anyone who would like to volunteer at MacHub with our Jobs Program can stop by and talk with our manager, Kendal McElfish.



► Meet Stevie & baby Kaden

In September of 2017, Stevie Dell and her four month old baby boy relocated from North Dakota to Oregon to stay with a family member. She realized after the first week that the situation wasn't working out as she had expected. Choosing sobriety over security, and in need of shelter, she had called more than a handful of shelters in the Portland area that were all full with long waiting lists. She called the Yamhill County Gospel Rescue Mission and was welcomed in right away. "I knew that was God providing," she said. "As a mom, the safety of my children is my number one priority, and I have always felt safe at the Mission."

While at the Mission, she was able to re-unite with her daughter after five years. She applied at 'My Father's House' in Gresham, and was put on a waiting list for 6 weeks. The staff there interviewed Stevie and seven others for one room that was available. They picked her! She joyously expressed that she would now be able to build a new life close to her daughter.
